

Waiver of Experiential Degree Requirement

Because practical experience as part of a rich academic program offers an undeniable advantage, all degree-seeking students must engage in one of several options for Experiential Learning credit. Those options include internship (paid or volunteer), study away, a business analysis project, a service learning project, a research project, or completion of the Business Honors Program. Students work with their academic advisor to determine which option is most appropriate.

We recognize that students may well be currently employed in an area directly related to their field of study. In this case we will consider recognizing this current, program-relevant work experience as completion of the degree requirement.
