

Notes on this production...

In February 1973 in a Wisconsin basement, Gary Gygax and Dave Arneson devised a set of table-top wargaming rules that envisioned a medieval fantasy game where brave adventurers crawled into dank and musty ruins to fight monsters and seek treasure. They called it Dungeons and Dragons (D&D), and today over 50 million people have played it in one edition or another. Every monster, demon, or critter that is mentioned in She Kills Monsters, can be found in D&D's 2nd Edition, with some creative liberties taken by 16-year-old Tilly's overactive imagination. Attentive listeners will catch plenty of pop-culture references from the 1990s, some more obvious than others. Over the course of She Kills Monsters, Tilly's sister Agnes goes through an adventure written by Tilly herself. Along the way, she fights unusual enemies, meets even more unusual allies, and faces some surprising truths about her little sister.

But in 1995, D&D was not yet the global phenomenon it is today. Rather, it was still an obscure and nerdy hobby viewed with suspicion by critics who accused it of promoting devil worship; exactly the sort of thing a geeky, outcast high schooler would be attracted to. D&D offers freedom from the mundanity and everyday cruelties of the real world. It offers freedom to be a kickass hero, to tell an awesome story, to laugh with your friends. However, in She Kills Monsters, D&D is more than just a game—it is a portal to a hidden world where the young protagonist, Tilly, can freely exercise her imagination and express her identity. Just as D&D was looked down on and mistrusted, so was homosexuality in 1995, when the play's action is situated. It was only three years before, in 1992, that the World Health Organization removed homosexuality from its International Classification of Diseases (ICD) with the publication of its revision 10. In 1993, the US Armed Forces introduced its controversial "Don't ask don't tell" policy and in 1996, President Clinton signed the Defense of Marriage Act into law, which recognized marriage as solely between a man and a woman, excluding same-sex couples from Federal law protections.

For Tilly, D&D is not just an escape from this repressive culture: it's a world where she can be fully herself, surrounded by friends who celebrate her. In a time when LGBTQ+

identities were still marginalized, the fantasy world she created becomes a safe space where her love and identity are unquestioned. For older sister Agnes, D&D is a lesson to embrace her community and her grief. This is the true power of a game like Dungeons and Dragons. It teaches us how to engage our imaginations and re-engage a child-like sense of play and wonder. It lets us express the struggles and conflicts we may not even be aware of in our day-to-day lives. It builds community, creates lifelong friendships, and gives rise to stories that bring us to laughter or tears. By stepping into this world that Tilly built and loved, Agnes finds not only a connection to her sister but a deeper understanding of the power of storytelling, identity, and the communities we build around the games we love.
