Synopsis of Packing Instruction 954

- Packages must be designed and constructed to permit the release of Carbon Dioxide Gas. This
 prevents the build-up of pressure that could rupture the package.
- The Proper Shipping Name (Dry Ice or Carbon Dioxide, Solid) and the net weight of the in kilograms must appear on the package.
- A Class 9 Hazard Label must appear on the package.
- Arrangements must be made between the shipper and operator to ensure ventilation safety procedures are followed.
- Shipment information must be included in the "Nature and Quantity of Goods" area on the air waybill.
- No Shipper's Declaration is required when shipping UN 3373 samples.
