Summer and Winter Driving Checklist

Tips for Safe Summer Driving

- Double check that all cargo is properly loaded and secured.
- Check that your vehicle tires, wipers, and lights are operational and in good condition.
- □ When roads are wet, increase following distance. Avoid driving through standing water. Pull over if visibility is impaired by rain or fog.
- During poor weather, turn on your low beams and slow down.
- □ Always use your flashers if you must pull over.
- □ If hydroplaning occurs, do not brake ease your foot off the accelerator and decrease speed gradually.
- □ Keep a well stocked emergency kit in the vehicle.

Tips for Safe Winter Driving

- □ Clear any accumulated snow or ice from all areas of your vehicle, including the windshield, hood, trunk, roof, and head and tail lights.
- □ Make sure headlights and taillights are visible and not obstructed by ice, snow, or mud. Check washer fluid level before driving on wet roads.
- □ Avoid driving on roads that have not been plowed or salted.
- □ Keep your headlights on at all times.
- □ Use caution on bridges and ramps. Be alert for the presence of black ice.
- □ Increase following distance and accelerate and brake slowly.
- □ Keep a well stocked emergency kit in the vehicle.
