

Guidelines for Quality Matters Official Course Reviews for Blended/Hybrid Courses

The Quality Matters (QM) course reviews of online and blended/hybrid courses use the same QM Rubric/standards to assess the quality of the design of these courses. Therefore, evidence for meeting the QM standards must be present in the blended/hybrid course shell.

The following is a list of the main components that are required to be available in the blended/hybrid course shell in order to be considered for QM Course Review.

- Measurable course and module/unit learning objectives.
- Assessments – If the assessments are taken face to face, instructions and corresponding objectives need to be available in the blended/hybrid course shell.
- Instructional Materials – These may include websites, articles, recorded lectures, and/or references to textbook readings. All face to face content is not subject to review, only that which is necessary for reviewing and assessing the alignment with learning objectives.
- Learning Activities and Learner Interaction – These may include activities that are occurring online and/or references to the face to face activities.
- Course Technology – These may include the list of technologies required to complete the course activities in addition to information on how to access the technology and technical support.
- Communication Plan – Include a communication plan in the course syllabus or the Start Here/Getting Started module. It must be clear to the learners what course components are occurring online and which ones are occurring face to face. Any course updates communicated face to face, should also be available in the online course.
