When does the clerkship lottery open and close?

Close: Tuesday, February 11, 2025
Schedules Posted: Thursday, February 20, 2025

What are the requirements for third year?


- Core Clerkships (40 weeks)
 - Family Medicine (4 weeks)
 - o Internal Medicine (8 weeks)
 - Neurology (4 weeks)
 - Obstetrics-Gynecology (8 weeks)
 - Pediatrics (8 weeks)
 - Psychiatry (4 weeks)
 - Surgery (8 weeks)
- Ambulatory Acting Internship (4 weeks)—opposite Family Medicine in Montgomery

How Does the lottery work?

- Each cohort of students in a track will take their clerkships in the same order.
- A cohort of students moves through the clerkship curriculum together.
- Students will submit preferences for their preferred order of clerkships
- Each student will get a complete schedule.




*Students in Huntsville and Montgomery typically take an ambulatory AI in place of elective. This practice reduces time on regional campus in MS4 year


How do I enter my lottery choices?


1. Login in with your Blazer ID.




2. Choose "Clerkships".



3. Use the up/down rank tracks in the order of preference.



4. When finished rearranging the tracks, click "Done". This saves the changes and sends an email to the student confirming their ranking. Students may re-rank tracks as often as they like while the lottery is open.



When do I get my results?

• Thursday, February 20, 2025 by 5:00 pm

What if I want to change my schedule?

- Drop/add for clerkships begins Thursday, February 27, 2025
- Review the video instructions on how to request a change using OSCR.
- Include a rationale for the change.
- Requests will be reviewed in the order received. When possible, changes will be made.
- If a change is not possible now, we may be able to make changes later in the year.

What about scheduling my Ambulatory AI or elective block?

- Students in **Montgomery** usually take an Ambulatory AI in place of an elective in 3rd year (opposite family medicine clerkship).

How do I schedule my Ambulatory AI?

• The AI/elective lottery opens on <u>March 4, 2025</u>. Return to the scheduling lottery page and choose Ambulatory AI.





- When you've finished arranging your choices, click Done and save your selections.
- You will receive an email confirming your ranking.
- You may re-rank courses as often as you like while the lottery is open.
- The Al/elective lottery closes on March 18, 2025.
- Ambulatory Als/electives will be posted to schedules on March 20, 2025.
- Drop/add requests for your Ambulatory AI or an elective can be made using OSCR beginning on Tuesday, April 1, 2025.

Things to keep in mind about the lottery and the 3rd year

- The order of clerkships does NOT
 - o Influence your ability to get into a specialty or program.
 - Predict grades
- You do not have to complete your lottery choices if you do not wish to.
- Under compelling circumstances, it is possible to make changes to your schedule later in the year. This requires approval from Britney and availability in the course. We cannot overbook.
- You must sit for Step 1 before beginning clerkships
- Pushing Ambulatory AI for elective
 - This is not guaranteed- you have to have a valid reason!
 - ***You will have more options if you have Medicine/Surgery earlier in the year***
 - Always remember if you push for an elective/AI there are prerequisites, and you will need to take housing/travel into consideration.
 - Will need to consider course availability (have 4th years to consider as well). Look at CAVE.
 - Overall- we recommend completing this requirement in the third year. You'll have one less AI to complete in 4th year!
 - If you choose to take a course on another campus during that time, consider the 8week branch campus coursework requirement for 4th year.
- Wednesday, April 30th and Thursday, May 1st 2025- Clerkship orientation. Mandatory!
