- Promotion criteria are based on the quality of an individual's substantive, documented contributions to the clinical missions of their division.
- Time alone in rank is not sufficient for promotion, but is considered.
- Promotions are effective January 1, unless made off-cycle.

Appointment, Promotion, and Tenure Committee (APTC)

Committee of 12 represents YOU!

The APTC is your advocate for faculty success.

The primary purpose of the DOP APTC is to:

- Make recommendations on (new) faculty appointments
- Review faculty member's 'body of work' to guarantee it meets DOP and SOM standards for promotion/tenure
- Assist in preparing dossier for submission to Faculty Council

Pay attention to annual vote for your APTC representatives!

Academic Pillars / Areas of Excellence

- 1. Teaching

There is an expectation that all academic faculty members engage productively in some form(s) of scholarship and develop a national reputation.



What's your Area of Excellence?

Teaching

- Leader or coursemaster for any SOM teaching programs
 - Courses developed
 - Expanded or developed educational area
 - Improvement of an existing program/course
- Lectures, rounds, seminars, preceptor, etc.
- Mentoring
 Tangible and measureable outcomes

What's your Area of Excellence?

Research

- Grants
 - Success over time with <u>evidence of future success</u>
 - Does not have to be NIH only
- Manuscripts (~20 for Assoc, 35-40 for Prof)
 - Include 'team science'
- Book chapters
- Abstracts
- Invited oral presentations
- Editorial boards, ad hoc reviews
- National planning, grant review, etc.

What's your Area of Excellence? Service / Leadership

- Development, leadership, or provision of unique clinical care or service, or clinical research
- High volume of patients/ high RVUs
- Development of new programs
- Development of new protocols
- Committees (UAB, regional, <u>national</u>, international)
- 'Citizenship'
- Team Science
- Community outreach activities related to specialty (Can be used for service or education as needed)

Ways to Gain a National Reputation

- Team science
- Leadership or service on national committees (more than just membership)
- Invited lectures, outside the Southeast
- Courses or protocols developed that have been adapted for use at institutions outside the Southeast

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
Promotion from Assistant to Associate Professor

- Typically no earlier than <u>fifth</u> year of appointment
- Requires National recognition
- Define area(s) of excellence, and be 'good' in the other(s)
- What all packages need:
 - Complete and vetted UAB CV and Portfolios
 - Portfolios should be <u>concise yet thorough</u>
 - Letters of Support (3 5 external and 3 5 internal)
 - DOP Chair/ Division Director Letter
 - Evidence of Scholarship (3)

Promotion from Associate to Full Professor and/or Tenure Award

- Typically a minimum of five years after promotion to Associate Professor
- National/International recognition
- Continued success in defined area(s) of excellence,
 and 'good' in the other(s)
- What all packages need:
 - Complete and vetted CV and Portfolios
 - Letters of Support (3 5 external and 3 5 internal)
 - DOP Chair/ Division Director Letter
 - Evidence of Scholarship (5)
 - Limit the fluff

What makes a promotion dossier?



Overview of P&T Timeline

- 5 <u>full</u> years in rank = standard period before being considered for promotion
- Faculty Evaluation and Division Director indicate readiness for promotion (Jan-Apr)
- 3. Proposal materials to DOP APTC by applicant/ Division Director (Sept)
- 4. DOP APTC vote and recommendation to move forward (October)*
- 5. APTC reviews final dossier for completeness (February)
- 6. Proposal to Faculty Council by Chair (March 1)
- 7. Faculty Council evaluates and provides a recommendation to Dean SOM (June)*
- 8. Proposal to the Provost by the SOM Dean and from Provost to the UAB President (Spring/Summer)
- 9. Decision by the UAB President and award (late summer/early Fall)
- 10. Promotions and tenure awards are effective October 1st
