HR Chest After Hours Guidelines

After Hours is considered Monday- Friday (5pm-7am), Weekends and Holidays

If the CT High Resolution Chest exam is ordered by the Pulmonary Team or has a Pulmonary consult, concentrate on the indication for the exam and follow the guidelines below:

HRCT (inspiration and expiration) without contrast: (use **<u>HR ILD</u>** protocol on the scanner)

- 1. New Patient with suspected interstitial lung disease (prone)
- 2. Suspected tracheobronchomalacia (supine)
- 3. Suspected small airway obstructive disease (supine)
- 4. Suspected BOS in lungTx patients (supine)
- 5. Pulmonary Hypertension (prone)

Thin section chest CT (inspiration only) without contrast: (use **<u>HR Bronchiectasis</u>** protocol on the scanner)

- 1. Follow up IPF/ILD exacerbation (SUPINE Prone if possible)
- 2. Suspected bronchiectasis (supine)
- 3. Evaluation of lung nodules (supine)
- 4. Sarcoidosis (supine)
- 5. Cystic fibrosis (supine)
- 6. Hemoptysis (supine)
- ▶ If the CT High Resolution Chest exam does **NOT** have any of the following:
 - 1. Ordered placed by the Pulmonary Team
 - 2. Have a Pulmonary consult
 - 3. Have one of the above indications

Use this Protocol:

HR After-hours chest CT (inspiration only, supine) without contrast:

 Perform a CT Chest without, <u>Inspiration ONLY - Supine</u>, using the <u>HR Chest after-hours</u> protocol on the scanner and the <u>CT Chest High Resolution orderable</u>.

<u>*DO NOT</u> ask clinician to change the order.
