

TAKE "MEASURES" TO ENSURE ACCESS

Minimum clearance for an accessible route should always be at least 3 feet. Use this yardstick to check for 3 foot clearance for all pathways and entrances when planning any campus events or spaces.



Micromobility devices like bikes and scooters can block access to pathways and entrances. DSS's "scooter violations" are designed to promote awareness of this issue on campus. To request scooter violations for your area, contact Disability Support Services.

Barrier Removal on Campus

As a community, our goal is to promote an inclusive environment that welcomes and provides optimal access to our campus for all people. This checklist is a tool to help building administrators identify common access barriers and readily achievable solutions. Generated in response to feedback from people with disabilities in our campus community, these are some of the top barriers to look out for:

PATHWAYS

- ❑ When walking across campus, always keep an eye out for blocked pathways
- ❑ If it is safe to do so, move scooters, bikes, and other obstacles to the side so that sidewalks can be accessed by all
- ❑ Attach a DSS scooter violation pamphlet to scooters that are blocking access to help raise awareness. You can access these pamphlets in our office or by emailing us at disability@uab.edu



ENTRANCES

- ❑ Start by making sure nothing is blocking push button door operators
- ❑ If a door does not open all of the way, check to make sure nothing is blocking the door path
- ❑ Periodically check to make sure the push button operator is functioning properly. If a button is out of order, contact facilities at (205) 934-9875
